

Notice of Tax Revenue Increase

The **Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 2** conducted public hearings on September 14, 2018 and September 19, 2018 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 2 from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 4.15 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$.09800 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$6,434,046.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$.10000 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$6,680,792.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$.10000 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$6,828,896.

The Board of Emergency Services Commissioners of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 2 is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 26, 2018 at 6:00 PM at 24655 Westheimer Parkway, Katy, Texas 77494.

The Commissioners of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 2 propose to use the increase in total tax revenue for the purpose of providing adequate personnel, stations and equipment to keep pace with growth in the District.
